

## Minutes of Blaenrheidol Community Council Meeting - 9th November 2021

The meeting was held at Ponterwyd Chapel, while keeping a safe distance and sanitising hands etc.

### **Matters Arising –**

The clerk reported that most of the repairs needed to the play equipment at the playarea had been completed.

A Maintenance Agreement for the Play Equipment received with a grant from Ceredigion County Council from 2019 needed to be signed. Therefore the Vice Chairman and clerk signed the document.
